Most recently, I have been working as a contract designer. A majority of my work has been as a package designer for PartyLite Gifts. I managed projects from start to finish. I served as a production artist, package designer and I corresponded with vendors during the proofing process. I created files for domestic and international distribution. I also worked on 3D renders for meetings and managed deadlines. To keep artwork consistent across the different brands, I organized the department by creating templates for all the various types of products and various package footprints. I also created artwork guides to help with the constant updates to the regulatory information that is shared with overseas vendors. At the same time, for other companies I have created logos, event fliers and posters, advertisements, t-shirt designs, business cards and other stationary.

Before this, I was the Senior Graphic Designer for Pacific World Corporation. I provided graphic support for all of Pacific World's brands, including Revlon, Fing'rs, Nailene and Bio-Oil. I was brought into the company to set up an in-house art department. I assisted in hiring other Graphic Designers that I trained. As a designer, I designed displays, packages, ads, retouched images, directed product photography. My other role was to be in constant communication with vendors to assure that the artwork was supplied correctly and by expected due dates. In the process of managing the department, I created an archival system for all artwork files and dies. This system could be accessed by anyone in the company, in California or otherwise.
